The Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS) Tasmania provides mobile dental outreach services to improve health outcomes for eligible people in rural and remote areas of Tasmania.



Dental conditions are the leading cause of potentially preventable hospitalisations in Tasmania.

The RFDS is able to assist by providing education, preventative and dental services for children under the age of 18 and adults holding a health care card who live in rural and remote communities across Tasmania.

The RFDS works in collaboration with existing dental providers and with cultural and community groups to deliver this free, government funded, service.

The services provided include:

- > Oral hygiene educational programs for schools and early learning centres
- > Preventative mobile dental treatment clinics for schools and early learning centres at their location
- > Dental treatment services in rural and remote areas for Adult Health Care Card Holders
